

Special Olympics Bharat, New Delhi

Minutes of the Meeting held on 20th February 2018 at National Office of SOB, New Delhi

The following members were present:

1. Dr. Kartikay Saini, Chairperson, SOB

At the onset, Dr. Kartikay Saini welcomed all members and briefed about appointment of a Selection Committee (World Summer Games, WSG 2019) for the forthcoming selections to take place during preparatory camps to be organized in different places of the country. Dr. Amitav Mishra, Chairperson of Selection Committee (National Championships) informed the members that preliminary selections during National Championships for various games have been already done. The athletes and coaches who have been selected as probable for 2019 World Special Olympics world summer Games have been informed to respective states and requested to send them to preparatory camps. The status of probable athletes and coaches after all championships are notified and uploaded to website to invite comments and observations from all stakeholders.

Mr. Victor Vaz informed that SOB has received quota for WSG 2019 and accordingly the further selection to be done by the Selection Committee based on the performance and merits of the athletes and coaches which can be observed during the preparatory camps.

As per quota allotted to SOB, the number of probable athletes and coaches can be reduced based on selection criteria of SOB/ MYAS.

Air Marshal D. Keelor , CEO, shared and briefed the members about the revised guidelines of the Ministry which have been adopted by SOB on formation of

selection committee and selection procedure. During the meeting the following decisions were made:

1. Dr. Kartikay Saini nominated Dr. Amitav Mishra to lead the selection committee as its Chairperson. He informed the members that based on certain credentials of Dr. Mishra, he has been nominated as Chairperson on his behalf for the following reasons: (i) he has more than 20 years of experience in Special Olympics, (ii) he is a certified Asia-Pacific Trainer of Special Olympics, (iii) he is an expert in the area of intellectual disability as well as (iv) he is a certified Rehabilitation Psychologist of Rehabilitation Council of India and (v) he is a Trustee and General Secretary of SOB.
2. It was decided that the Committee shall be further comprised of National Sports Director/National Coach as member. It was decided that a person expert in GMS and a Technical person should be included in the selection committee as invited members to assist the committee. Mr. Vaz informed that Ms. Sulekha Rana and Mr. Sagar Choudhary from the National office may be considered for this. The members agreed for the proposal.
3. It was decided to have a game specific National/Regional trainer to be a member for each game specific committee. Mr. Victor Vaz informed that Judo is a newly introduced game for Special Olympics and all those who are national trainers of Judo are already part of the probable coaches. It was decided that as a special case, a person who is qualified and experienced in Judo may be considered for this. The members deliberated about on identifying suitable persons who are competent to undertake this important assignment as member of the selection committee. After a detailed deliberation, the following persons were considered to be part of the selection committee:


