

Executive Summary

The World Health Day 2022 created a milestone for Special Olympics Bharat, amplifying the message of Inclusion in decibels unheard of in its history so far. Recovering from the impact of the global pandemic SO Bharat envisioned a methodical entry of the Athletes with Intellectual Disability into the sporting field, planning their health assessment as a first step.



Over 102,037 health screenings including Health Promotion (Prevention & Nutrition), Opening Eyes (Eye examination) and Special Smiles (Dental screening) were conducted across 139 locations in 31 States and Union Territories of India. The North Eastern region of India is a tough terrain, however 5 out of 7 states of the North East Region proactively activated their states. Over 78379 Athletes were screened for which 8772 Medical professionals were trained prior to the event. 155 Assistant Clinical Directors, a new unit of medical experts, were trained, to support and fill up at locations where the Clinical Directors were not present. They were trained in a series of trainings held physically as well as virtually and will continue to support SO Bharat Healthy Athletes for the next twelve months.

On 3 December 2021, International Day for Persons with Disabilities, the festival was officially announced at a ceremony held in FICCI, New Delhi with the aim to reach out to as many partners while spreading awareness about SO Bharat and the abilities of the Special Athletes. The buzz around giving wings to the dreams of the General Secretary, DR DG Chaudhari within no time snowballed into a structured plan with multiple youth joining to execute it, various **departments of the Govt of India** mustering support of twenty-three partnerships, including, PSUs, Media, Corporates etc, forged at the National level. Fundraising endeavours scaled up, wherein approx. INR 7.2 CR (USD 9,27,900) was raised nationally. **Media** partnerships were forged and approx. 1000 journalists from 400 Media houses were reached that covered 300 features, stories all over India. **Social Media** across all SO Bharat handles peaked between 1 December 2021 and 30 April 2022.



On separate counts, **SO Bharat was awarded** with the prestigious Guinness Book of Records, World Talent organisation Award, Asia Book of Records and has attempted the Limca Book of Records

Another feather in the cap emerged in the form of a **digital platform developed in India**, to manage one of the largest single day health screening programs, perhaps, ever attempted. The app would house a robust

database making it possible for anyone to directly reach out to the athletes, which earlier was not possible.

A National Program with a Global Vision

Return to Play

The Covid 19 global pandemic posed a huge setback to sports as well as the health of the Athletes. Since March 2020 the Athletes and coaches were forced to stay indoors, abandoning their passion tied to the sports field. The need of the hour led to virtual modules of sports that salvaged the situation. It was successful in enabling everyone to stay connected and upscaled cross- interactions. The year 2021 introduced a hybrid model that











20 Jan 2022- Registrations of Athletes opened

Registrations for the Clinical Directors & Volunteers opened on the 10th of Jan while those for the Athletes opened on 20 January 2022




22Jan 2022- 75-day Countdown to the World Health Day

Special Olympics Bharat trained **155 Assistant Clinical Directors** through In-person training programs held at Kochi, Pune, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Delhi and Ahmedabad held between 6 March and 6 April 2022, while **8482 medical professionals** were trained through the virtual platform between 21st – 25th March 2022. The participants were Clinical Volunteers for Special Smiles from the Dental Colleges, for Health Promotion from the Nutrition & nursing Colleges and there would be the Physio-therapists, Occupational Therapist & Sports Coaches for the fitness corner examination of 20 Athletes across both the disciplines, as well.











THE EPICENTRE – AHMEDABAD GUJARAT



The program saw largest participation from the states of Kerala and Gujarat. Kerala registered 11,339 athletes and conducted events in 15 locations, while Gujarat registered 10,516 athletes and conducted events in Surat and Ahmedabad.

The maximum screenings in any one location were held in the Karnavati University, Gandhinagar, Gujarat, where over 7500 athletes were

screened. Speaking on the occasion, Additional Director, Karnavati University, Prof. (Dr.) Rohan Bhatt said, "We had over 1800 volunteers on ground on the day of the screening including university students, doctors and masters' students working relentlessly. I am very thankful to them for being able to execute this mammoth task of successfully conducting screenings of over 7500 intellectually disabled athletes here at our premises." The University was one of the venues where the Guinness record was attempted The National program culminated in a grand celebration held at the Narendra Modi Stadium, Ahmedabad. To witness the large-scale screening as well as to attend the closing ceremony program officials from Special Olympics International headquarters and the Asia Pacific Region travelled to the city. Their visit entailed deliberations around Return to activities and the way forward from hereon





Heartening Outcomes

An Athlete with an Intellectual Disability re-unites with his family

Story from Madhya Pradesh



The National Health Fest held on 7 April focussed on the preparedness of the Athlete to return to activities. It may amaze how the largest fest ever, and that too specifically, for Persons with Intellectual Disability, aided achievements from perspectives that may be beyond the official radar. As the days pass and the thrill of the culmination of the festival ebbs out, the profound impact of the nation-wide celebration is beginning to surface from different parts of India.

Anas Ashfak Khan, fondly called Laloo, 15 yrs, participated in the Guinness attempt in Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh, on 7 April 2022. He is a person with Downs Syndrome, a challenged speech & has a mild Intellectual disability. For registrations for the event, a few documents were required for establishing the identity of the Athletes which would position them to avail



benefits of several Govt schemes for Persons with Disabilities in future. Laloo applied for his Aadhaar card. Records showed that it was already made. The perseverance of the state govt officials traced his family back to Jalgaon in Maharashtra. Laloo was reunited with his family. Through a video call, he instantly recognised and called out for his sister's husband. Following a thorough verification process, Laloo will be travelling back with his family, once all

the paper work is over. Laloo was brought to the Govt facility for abandoned children with Intellectual Disability in Jabalpur, Madhya Pradesh, in 2017 where his age was estimated to be 10 at that time.

"According to me the fest is nothing short of being WONDERFUL. Amongst all the disabilities, intellectual disability often is overlooked. This fest, in terms of scale and specification of benefitting the persons with ID, has never been heard of earlier. In my location about 3000 Athletes were screened; and all now have Aadhaar cards, Disability certificates etc. this will help them avail all the benefits in future. Aadhar card is the greatest challenge. The govt officials assign one day in a week to make it. However, for this event they worked round the clock and created a dream future for so many Children and Adults with Intellectual Disability" Ms Vanmala Rai, Special Educator at the facility.

Telangana assigned Special Athletes who are professional photographers, to take photos at the event

The National Health fest organized at Name of Center, had two passionate photographers capturing moments within the frame-Jagadish and Vijay. Jagadish, 42 years, is a person with Downs Syndrome, and Vijay, 20 yrs has an Intellectual Disability. Both have participated in Special Olympics Bharat events at district level, in Athletics and Bocce. For several years

Follow Up Care: Medical Educational Institutions and Hospitals are being tapped to support follow up Care of the Athletes

Sport Centres: The next three years, including 2022 will see 750 sports Centres establish, taking sports closer to the Athletes and integrating it into their daily lives. The Centres will provide expanded sports and inclusive experiences to

persons with and without Intellectual Disability, in an environment of equity and acceptance of all. The plan falls in sync with the goal of Special Olympics to improve local sports participation and wellbeing of athletes to strengthen communities

The Athletes will be trained in specified sports under the mentorship of an employed Coach assisted by an Athlete leader (trained & employed as Assistant Coach). The Centres would be assigned spaces across sports clubs, academies, schools, colleges etc. SO Bharat is reaching out to Govt organisations and corporates for financially supporting any number of Centres for a period of three years, to begin with.

Digital App: The digital team that includes Barnik, Sayan and Pritam plan to adapt the screening platform into a daily use feature wherein athletes can setup appointments with medical professionals and get screened outside Special Olympics events.

They would create a wider feature to manage and run sports Centres across the country where athletes can train and practice their favorite sports. Building the platform as an aggregator for the unified programs of Special Olympics
