Special Olympics Bharat is committed to promoting clean sport, athlete health, and integrity in competition.

Participation in international Special Olympics events is governed by the Anti-Doping Rules of Special Olympics International (SOI). While Special Olympics International is not a member of the World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), it maintains a strict anti-doping policy focused on athlete safeguarding and participant education, aligned with internationally recognised clean sport principles.

Athletes selected to represent Special Olympics Bharat at international events are subject to the SOI regulations applicable to those competitions.

At the national level, Special Olympics Bharat promotes education and awareness regarding clean sport and responsible use of medications in accordance with applicable guidelines.

Special Olympics Bharat encourages all athletes, coaches, and support personnel to uphold clean sport values and to seek appropriate medical guidance regarding medications and supplements.
